Dubrovnik is situated in Southern Dalmatia, the most beautiful part of the Adriatic coast. Rich vegetation, beautiful lakes, rare islands, white pebble beaches and the crystal clean sea, all make this region to an unforgettable experience for every visitor. Dubrovnik Region consists of numerous small "jewels" that are worth visiting, small authentic villages, untouched islands and, of course, the Old Town of Dubrovnik, the crown jewel of them all, the island of Lokrum, right in front of the Old city and the most popular excursion point of the inhabitants of Dubrovnik, the arboretum in Trsteno – a collection of centuries old plants and trees, which were brought by Dubrovnik's seamen from all over the world, visit Ston and its mighty city walls, come to Konavle and Konavoski dvori, feel a real familiar atmosphere and taste some delicious food, spend at least one afternoon in Cavtat, make a whole day cruise to the Elaphites, an archipelago in the surroundings of Dubrovnik, take a boat ride to the town of Korčula – the miniature of Dubrovnik, wonderful small town on the Island of Korčula, visit the National park on the Island of Mljet – one of the seven Croatian national parks and in this oasis of peace and silence enjoy the beauty of Big and Small lakes.

For you we prepared a range of bespoke excursions. If you're not a fan of big coaches and set excursions this will be the best option for you. We prepared a few suggested itineraries but the best thing of these programs is that you will set your own timing. If you are more of a history type person we will take you to the most famous museums and if you are a fan of beaches we will take you to the best beaches that a destination can provide.

Peljesac peninsula with wine tasting and Trsteno botanical gardens

Enjoy the perfect day visiting one of the most important Croatian wine regions, the Pelješac peninsula.

- Departure from Dubrovnik around 9 AM.
- After arrival to the peninsula we will visit one of the most famous domestic

wineries where you will have the opportunity to do wine tasting together with some great snacks.

- Departure from the peninsula towards the ancient city of Ston which was a border of Dubrovnik republic in ancient times and offers longest city walls in this part of Europe.
- Time for lunch after sightseeing in one of the cosiest restaurants in Ston. Try famous Ston Oysters and other sea food – it is really delicious.
- On the way back we will stop in Trsteno botanical gardens – 5 centuries old collection of plants and trees that will leave you breathless.
- Arrival to Dubrovnik around 18.00.

Island of Korcula and Peljesac vineyards

The island of Korcula and the peninsula of Peljesac were inhabited even in the Neolithic Age, i.e. six to eight thousand years ago. There are numerous archeological findings from that time, ranging from the first settlements, caves, tumuli, and old stone buildings to the earliest tools such as stone axes, pieces of ceramics and flint knives.

- Depart from Dubrovnik around 9 AM.
- After a comfortable drive through picturesque villages of Pelješac Peninsula we will stop in Potomlje – town famous for its wineries. Opportunity to taste some famous domestic wines and food.
- After the tasting we will depart for Orebić, municipal town of the Peninsula, just a short boat ride from the island of Korčula. Sightseeing of the town and free time to visit beaches and good restaurants.
- Departure for Dubrovnik around 4 PM and a short stop in Ston. Arrival to Dubrovnik around 7 PM.

Mostar & Međugorje sanctuary

Mostar is situated north-west of Dubrovnik. It is the second largest town in Bosnia (after Sarajevo, the Bosnian capital). The town shows the Ottoman influences with typical Turkish architecture blended with traditional Bosnian housing, as well as Christian and Orthodox monuments. It is believed that Mostar was the dividing point between western and eastern world.

Međugorje is a world famous Christian sanctuary where pilgrims from all around the world come to find God, faith and peace. It is believed that Blessed Virgin Mary appeared in Međugorje on several occasions in the past few decades.

- Departure from Dubrovnik around 9 AM.
- Arrival at Međgorje at 11.00 and free time.
- Departure for Mostar at 13.00. Sightseeing tour includes visits to Turkish house, mosque, orthodox and christian church and visit to the famous Mostar bridge (Mostar actually means bridge town).
- Free time with recommendations for best restaurants in town and departure for Dubrovnik at 5 PM with arrival at 7 PM.

Konavle tour – Čilipi - Konavoski dvori

Let us show you one of the best preserved regions in the Dubrovnik area – Konavle, located south from Dubrovnik. Konavle region is famous for its preserved folk customs and rich cultural and historical heritage.

- Departure from Dubrovnik at 9 AM.
- Short stop in Cavtat – municipal center of the Konavle region.
- After a short sightseeing of the famous Meštorvić Mausoleum and a coffee on the famous lungo mare we will depart for Čilipi – a village known for its carefully preserved folk customs, rich national costumes and famous embroidery. Enjoy your stay in this idyllic setting by walking round this picturesque village, buy a traditional souvenir or attend Mass at St. Nicholas' church. Folklore performances are hosted in front of the church every Sunday– the ultimate day for this excursion).
- Our drive through the villages Popovići and Radovčići takes us to Molunat for a photo break. Lunch will follow at the restaurant Konavoski Dvori. Enjoy the romantic charm created by the swift river lined with greenery, exceptional wines and traditional cuisine of the area.
- Arrival to Dubrovnik around 17.00

Montenegro Tour

This scenic drive along the Dubrovnik Riviera passes above a charming town of Cavtat and travels through the villages of the Konavle region until the Montenegro border, the youngest independent republic in Europe.

This land of magical landscapes and intriguing history offers much more than one can absorb in just one day.

- You will be introduced to some of the highlights of Montenegro, starting with Kotor. This ancient town provides a wonderful setting for a walking tour through its narrow streets full of charm of times long passed.
- Continuing your excursion, you will take a winding road through the tall hills surrounding Kotor Bay enjoying a breathtaking panoramic view.
- You will soon find yourself in Cetinje, former capital of Montenegro. Maybe the best witness to the importance of Cetinje in the history of Montenegro is Museum of King Nicholas. The tour of this museum will give you an insight into the way royal families of that era lived.
- After Cetinje, it is time to go back to the coastline and visit the seaside jewel of Montenegro – town of Budva.
- After stopping at a panoramic viewpoint above Sveti Stefan resort you will make your way to downtown Budva and partake in a short tour of its old city center.
- Drive back to Dubrovnik will be shortened by a ferry ride across the Bay of Boka Kotorska.

Prevlaka Adventure Park

This excursion will give you a chance to get your adrenaline pumping as you visit Prevlaka, the southernmost point of Croatia. You will enjoy one hour scenic drive southwards with a photo stop above the Old City of Dubrovnik before you reach the Adrenaline park. Here you will engage in one of the exciting activities therein. Please note that activities should be selected 24 hours prior to departure.

Activities include:

- Paint-ball – minimum 6 persons
- Free Climbing – minimum 4 persons
- Bike Rental;
- Kayak Rental

After an exciting afternoon of outdoor fun, you will be returned to Dubrovnik for a well deserved rest.

Dubrovnik Sunset

Area of Dubrovnik has served as an inspiration for writers, painters, and poets for centuries. This is your chance to find out why as you are introduced to the beauty of the Dubrovnik Riviera.

- After a panoramic stop above the city your minibus will make it's way to the magical seaside town of Cavtat, a popular celebrity destination. This peaceful Mediterranean town is perfect for relaxing. After a short introduction by your guide enjoy exploring Cavtat on your own before boarding your minibus once again.
- Your tour will then take you to Velji Do promontory, probably the most spectacular viewpoint of the entire area. You will be able to see Dubrovnik Riviera, Montenegro, and locals claim it is even possible to see Italy on a clear day.
- After a photo stop, you will be taken to one of the famous Konavle region restaurants for dinner.
- This memorable afternoon will be completed by a scenic drive back to Dubrovnik.
